#### REGULATIONS

The final text of these Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version which will be used should any dispute arise as to their interpretation. Together with English the official language of organising country can be used. Headings in this document are for ease of reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

#### Article 1 – Organisation

The Event shall be run in accordance with the International Sporting Code and its appendices, the FIA and CIK-FIA official Bulletins, the General Prescriptions applicable to the CIK-FIA Karting international Events and Championships, Cups and Trophies, the Specific Prescriptions applicable to the CIK-FIA Karting Championships, Cups and Trophies, the Sporting Regulations of the FIA/NEZ Karting Championship (the Sporting Regulations) and these Supplementary Regulations.

#### Article 2 – Information specific to the Event

##### NEZ Karting Championship event

The Championship will be run in one event, comprising Free Practice, Qualifying Practice, Qualifying Heats, Second Change Heat and Final. The results of final will obtain the Championship / NEZ Junior Trophy.

##### Eligible Drivers

Licences accepted:

**KF3:** minimum CIK/FIA International Karting Licence, Grade C. Age of driver 13 – 15 years, national age regulations.

**KF6 (Junior 60):** National Licence. Age of driver: 10 – 13 years, national age regulations.

Details for the Support Race of KZ2 will be published latest 22/06/2011.

Only licence holders of the following countries are eligible: Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Iceland, Latvia, Lithuania, Norway, Russia and Sweden.

##### Entries

Each ASN is having the right to choose 6 drivers to both NEZ classes. **Entry closing date is 08/07/2011.**

The number of entries is limited to maximum 45 per NEZ class. In the first round of selection process will be chosen maximum 5 drivers from every list in the order which each ASN has announced. After this first round of selection, it will be supplied one driver per ASN in alphabetical order (starting from Denmark) among these ASN's which have nominated more than 6 drivers. It will be organized as many rounds as there are nominated drivers. However in any case not more than 45 drivers will be selected. At the end the Organizing ASN has the right to take those possible remaining places.

##### Entry fee

Entry fee is 190,00 € and it must be paid according the orders of the organiser given in the entry form.
